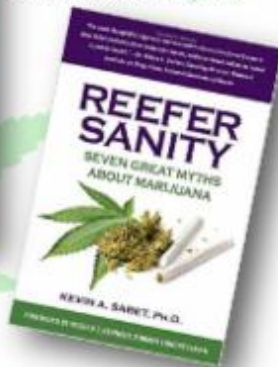

NISKA-GAME IS COMING!!! November 6 & 7 at Van Antwerp MS NISKA-GAME IS COMING!!!



Calling all 6th, 7th and 8th Graders to start forming your Teams for Niskayuna's own giant Monopoly game!

For close to 30 years, on a weekend in November, Niskayuna Middle School students have participated in Niska-Game... a life-sized game modeled after the popular game of Monopoly with properties named for local landmarks and businesses.

The game takes no more than 3 hours to play and features teams of about 10 players. They move around the board after tossing life sized dice, using themselves as the game pieces. Along the way, they are requested to do skits or answer trivia questions posed to them by the judges, who are community leaders!

In addition to middle school students playing on a team, parent volunteers are needed to help in many ways, from baking for our snack bar to working on registrations or team organizing.
